

**RESOLUTION 2014-04**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF POLK CITY, FLORIDA;  
PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF THE CITY OF POLK CITY  
VISION PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission sought to ascertain the community vision for future downtown and city-wide development through a community based planning process; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Workshops were held with government officials, community residents, members of the business community, and interested persons on August 29, 2013, November 4, 2013, and March 24, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, each Community Workshop progressively built upon and confirmed information and ideas expressed by community members; and

**WHEREAS**, comments and suggestions obtained during the community workshops and public events were recorded and brought forward through illustrative artistic renderings; and


**WHEREAS**, the proposed Polk City Vision Plan was presented to the government officials, community residents, members of the business community, and interested persons on May 8, 2014, at an Open House; and



**INTRODUCED AND PASSED** by the City Commission of the City of Polk City, Florida, in regular session, this 21<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2014.


