## **PART TWO**

**For the month of February there were three reported PROCAP crimes in the city limits. The first was the theft of a child's four wheeler from 4<sup>th</sup> Street, the second was a criminal mischief, the final crime was a burglary and theft of a debit card in which both suspects were identified, located and arrested.**

**Of special concern is a recent trend of mail theft. At least two reports have been received regarding mail theft from within the city limits. Numerous reports have been received in the surrounding area from as far north as Poyner Road south along S.R. 33 to Mount Olive Road and further down into the Lakeland area.**
