In April 2011, there were five (5) PROCAP crimes reported compared to seven (7) in April of 2010. Three residential burglaries occurred during the month. One was on Abbey Dr. where there was a lawn mower stolen. The second one occurred on Pine Ave. where a desktop computer was stolen. The third one occurred on Ashley Rd. where two televisions where stolen. There are no investigative leads at this time and the cases have been turned over to detectives for follow up investigation.

An armed robbery occurred on the side of the road at Berkley and Honeybee Ln. The victim was held on the ground by two known suspects and this clothes and personal property were stolen. The victim did not report the incident until later in the evening. The two suspects were located and attempted to flea from Deputies. The suspects were arrested and charged with additional criminal charges.

A Criminal Mischief occurred on Pine Ave. where a known suspect kicked in the front door of a residence during an aguement. The known suspect was charged by complaint affidavit.
