Subject:

In October 2011, there were Eleven (11) PROCAP captured crimes compared to eight (8) in October of 2010. There were two (2) burglaries to vehicles during the month. One occurred at the Van Fleet Trial Head and the other occurred at the Polk City Elementary School. A Criminal Mischief occurred at the Van Fleet Trail Head where an unknown suspect broke out a window to a vehicle.

Two grand thefts occurred during one night. One was at the Ice Cream Shop and the other was at the vacant house next to the Ice Cream Shop. Two Petit thefts occurred during the month one was at a residence on Sunset Blvd. where a cellular phone was stolen. The other was at the Circle K Store on Commonwealth Ave.

Two residential burglaries occurred during the month. One was on 2nd street and the other was on 4th Street. Both residences were vacant at the time of the thefts. All cases have been assigned to the Polk County Sheriff's Office Northwest investigations for follow up investigations.

Two retail thefts have occurred during the month at the Chevron Station on Commonwealth Ave. In each of the thefts a suspect was arrested and charged.
