In December 2011, there were eight (8) PROCAP captured crimes reported compared to one (1) in December 2010. There were two vehicle burglaries reported. One occurred on Commonwealth Ave. at the Fire Station, and the other occurred on Broadway Blvd. at the Dollar General Store.

A Business burglary occurred on Commonwealth Ave at the Statues and More business. Entry was gained and the business alarm activated. The suspects were gone prior to the Deputies arrival. A Structure burglary occurred at the construction site of the Dollar Market. Brass pipes and fittings were stolen. There were no signs of forced entry, and the time of theft could not be determined.

A Grand theft occurred at the Hungry Howies pizza restaurant where a box of toys were stolen that were donated for the local toys for tots program. Two suspects were identified by P.C.S.O. Northwest Detectives and they were arrested.

A Petit theft occurred on Meadering Way where an unknown suspect stole a For Sale sign out of the victim's yard. A Criminal Mischief occurred on Broadway Ave. at the Dollar General Store where someone damaged the metal side of the building. The damage was estimated at \$800.00.

A Criminal Mischief occurred on Greenleaf Ln. where a known suspect damaged a window near the front door. The suspect admitted her part in this offense and was arrested. All unsolved cases are being investigated by P.C.S.O. Northwest Detectives for Follow up investigations.
