# Summary of March 12, 2012 City Council Meeting

- Polk County Fire Chief Cash brought his team located in Polk City, and 2 new trucks came to the Polk City Council Meeting for a tour of the latest equipment.
- Proclamation of the Girl Scouts "Year of the Girl" in 2012.
- Ordinance 2012-02 amending Chapter 74 Utilities; amending Section 74-251, deposits required providing for severability; providing for conflicts; providing an effective date – First Reading. In summary, the water deposit would be \$150 inside or outside the city. Motion Carried: 4 - ayes, 1 - nay
- Transfer of funds from the Enterprise Fund to the General Fund \$197, 97 to be transferred from the Enterprise Fund Debt Service (Fifth Third Bank Bonds) to the General Fund Debt Service (Fifth Third Bank Bonds). This has no impact on the budget
- Safe Route to School Grant There will be one project for this year a proposed sidewalk will connect the train and run east on Berkley to S.R.33
- CDBG Grant Bids are due back March 21<sup>st</sup> by 2:00 p.m.
- Water, Wastewater and Reuse System Improvements --Pre-Bid Conference was held March 21<sup>st</sup> and sealed bids are due back to the city on April 11 by 2 p.m.
- Auditors were here in March to finish the audit.
- Customers can now review and pay utilities online.
- Changes Due to State Legislation Legal ads will be posted on the website of the newspaper at no additional cost. There were other changes in cost favorable to municipalities.

#### Lawn Watering Schedule and Times

- Lawn watering is limited to twice per week.
- Lawn watering days and times are as follows unless your city or county has a different schedule or stricter hours in effect:
  - o Even addresses may water on Thursday and/or Sunday before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m.
  - o Odd addresses may water on Wednesday and/or Saturday before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m.
  - Locations without a discernable address, such as rights-of-way and other common areas inside a subdivision, may water on Tuesday and/or Friday before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m.
