#### Summary of February 18, 2012 City Council Meeting

- Republic Services rescheduled introduction of new manager to our area
- Safe Route to Schools Grant Envisors (engineering firm) is applying for the grant again in 2013. This grant provides funding for sidewalks making a child's walk to school safer. The cost of applying for the grant is \$2500
- Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be making improvements on SR 33. Polk City and Woodard and Curran are in the process of locating the cities utilities and GAI will be marking the plans to designate where the utilities are located for FDOT review. Motion passed.
- Mount Olive Wastewater Treatment Plant shutdown has been completed. Work continues to demolish the site.
- Community Development Block Grant Project for water line project should be completed by mid-March.

#### Councilor Trudy Block Goes to Washington DC

- Polk City Councilor Trudy Block traveled to Washington in February to meet with Senator Bill Nelson, Congressman Daniel Webster, Congressman Dennis Ross and other from Central Florida. This was a great week to visit as the Florida League of Cities team of elected officials discussed 3 topics with the Legislators that would affect cities negatively.
  - Municipal Bonds Congress is discussing taxation on Muni Bonds
  - Marketplace Fairness (Sales Tax for online sales) Congressman Dennis Ross is sponsoring House Bill # 684 and there is an accompanying Senate Bill # 336
  - The Sequester the negative impact the Sequester will have on cities

#### **Hazardous Intersection Gets Additional Signage**



The intersection at CR 557 and SR 559 (near Camp Gilead and Fantasy of Flight) has always been a hazardous intersection. There have been numerous accidents and many near misses over the years.

Councilor Trudy Block serves on the Polk County Transportation Planning Board representing Polk City. She requested additional signage from Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) below the STOP sign reminding drivers that the cross-traffic does not stop.

Thank you to FDOT for their quick response to the request. The additional signage can now be seen below both stop signs.

### Polk County Burn Ban – Until further notice

Due to the extended drought, Polk County Fire Rescue officials have issued a burn ban. "We have held off as long as we possibly can on issuing this burn ban," said Polk County Fire Rescue Chief David Cash, "Conditions are favorable for the rapid development and spread of brush fires and we need to take every step necessary to ensure the safety of Polk's residents and their property."

The burn ban includes, but is not limited to, the burning of trash, yard debris, campfires, bonfires, construction debris and fireworks. Any person who refuses to comply with this burn ban shall be in violation of County Ordinance 08-105, which is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 or by imprisonment by a term not to exceed 60 days in the county jail or both.
