**Republic Services** will collect Garbage, Recycle, and Bulk on Monday, December 21<sup>st.</sup> Yard waste will be collected on Wednesday, December 23<sup>rd</sup>. Normal operations no change in collection schedule.

**Polk County Resident Collection Service** in the unincorporated areas – Monday December 21<sup>st</sup>, Tuesday December 22<sup>nd</sup>, Wednesday December 23<sup>rd</sup> and Thursday December 24<sup>th</sup>, garbage, recycle, yard waste and bulk will remain on normal schedule. Friday December 25<sup>th</sup> garbage, recycle, yard waste and bulk will be collected on Saturday December 26<sup>th</sup>.

This schedule will be the same for January in observance of the New Year's Holiday on January 1, 2016.
