175 gallons per month.....Run your washing machine and dishwasher only when full.

250 gallons per month.....Rinse fruit and vegetables in a bowl of water instead of under running water.

390 gallons per month.....Replace your conventional clothes washer with a new water-efficient model.

675 gallons per month....Turn off the water while brushing your teeth and shaving.

690 gallons per month.....Install water-saving showerheads and limit showers to five minutes.

870 gallons per month.....Replace older toilets with new low-flow models.
