What you need to know...Florida Building Code – Building Chapter 45

Residential Swimming Pools – Any structure intended for swimming, recreational bathing or wading that contains water over 24 inches (610 mm) deep. This includes in-ground, aboveground and on-ground pools; hot tubs; spas and fixed-in-place wading pools. Any pump or filtration system a must be permitted. Swimming pools, including all decking and screen enclosures, shall be located to the rear of the front building line, and shall not encroach into side yard setback areas.

2020 Water Quality Reports

Polk City produces a Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) annually in accordance with regulatory guidelines. This report is designed to give customers a snapshot of the City's water quality for the previous year. The City's CCR, which has been approved by the Polk County Health Department, is available online for interested customers to view at the links provided below.
