Vtility Billing

As of February 1, 2022, we will continue our disconnection policy, delinquent accounts subject to disconnection will be charged a service/nonpayment fee of \$50.00 if not paid by the 5th after 5:00 p.m., and will be disconnected without notice after the 5th. In all cases where water has been disconnected, a reconnect fee of \$55.00 will apply. (Sec.74-255). If reconnection is requested outside of normal business hours, a \$100.00 after hours reconnection fee will apply.
