The Books Bridge Bus will be visiting every Monday from 1:30 pm - 4:15 pm (except for the week of July 4th)!

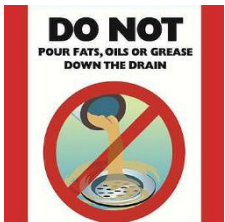
Registration links will be posted on the Library's Facebook the Friday, before each event. Registration is limited to 50 people per event, please register for everyone in attendance (Kids + Adults).

Help Us Keep the Sewer Flow On the Go!!!!!!



As staff continues to work tirelessly removing wipes, diapers, mop heads, feminine pads, this is an **URGENT PLEA to TOSS THESE ITEMS IN THE GARBAGE CAN**....they do not break down quick enough within the sanitary sewer system. Combined with other materials put down the drain, will cause the large pumps to break, which is what helps move the wastewater through the collections system as it makes it way to the Wastewater Treatment Facilities! **A blocked/broken pump can equal costly sewer back-up into your home, business or the natural environment!**



You **SHOULD NOT** pour grease down **YOUR HOME DRAIN OR THE CITY'S STORM DRAIN** because it solidifies as it cools, clogs pipes, and can cause major plumbing issues and sewer backups. This solidified grease can trap other debris, leading to even larger blockages. It will negatively impact wastewater treatment plants.

Utility Billing

As a reminder, Polk City's disconnection policy is as follows, delinquent accounts subject to disconnection will be charged a delinquent/nonpayment fee of \$50.00 if not paid by the 5th after 2:00 p.m. and will be disconnected without notice after the 5th. In all cases where water has been disconnected, a reconnect fee of \$55.00 will apply (Sec.74-255). If reconnection is requested outside of normal business hours, a \$100.00 after hours reconnection fee will apply. Methods of payment: cash, check, money order, credit card, echeck online or you may now call City Hall to make your payment during regular business hours.

The completed application can be submitted via US Mail, email, fax or drop box at City Hall with the required documentation (Property Ownership Documentation, Rental Agreement, Government Issued Identification).
