Polk City, Florida, is requesting formal bids for the replacement of the headworks bar screen and splitter box and modifications to an existing aeration basin wall at the Cardinal Hill WWTF, Polk City FL.

Summary of Work: Remove the existing splitter box with bar screen and receiving structure, and dispose or recycle the materials, work with City to close and divert flow to temporary headworks (existing); provide all labor, tools, materials, equipment, machinery, cranes, coordination, and incidentals required to install proposed, slightly larger, headworks and bar screen structure. Details of proposed design are provided in the design drawings and technical specifications titled "Cardinal Hill Wastewater Treatment Facility Bar Screen Replacement", CSDG Project No. 354-003003 and are available digitally, by request, from cfuller@civilsurv.com.
