

## Recap of March 26, 2024 Special City Commission Meeting

- 2. Ordinance 2024-02 First Reading Approved
- 3. Resolution 2024-02 Adopted





- Yard sales in residential areas are allowed **six times per calendar year** for the sale of the owner's personal items.
- Community (Block) yard sales are allowed **two times per calendar year** for the combination sale of individuals residing in that area.
- Yard sales shall be limited to three days in duration and shall require the issuance of a permit by Polk City.
- There is currently NO FEE for the permit; however, we ask that you complete an application to register your yard sale at City Hall

## Help Vs Keep the Sewer Flow On the Go!!!!!!




**TOSS THE WIPES** in the garbage can.....flushable wipes do not break down quick enough within the sanitary sewer system. These wipes eventually combine with other materials put down the drain and can break the large pumps that help move the wastewater through the collections system as it makes it way to the Wastewater Treatment Facilities! A blocked pump can equal costly sewer back up into your home, businesses or the natural environment!

Garbage Rates Increase



Garbage Rate increase as of January 2024 Residential rate to the customer will be \$24.39 per month Dumpster rate to the customer will be \$12.06 per yard Commercial Cans rate to the customer will be \$68.91 per month



As a reminder, Polk City's disconnection policy is as follows, delinquent accounts subject to disconnection will be charged a delinquent/nonpayment fee of \$50.00 if not paid by the 5<sup>th</sup> after 2:00 p.m. and will be disconnected without notice after the 5<sup>th</sup>. In all cases where water has been disconnected, a reconnect fee of \$55.00 will apply (Sec.74-255). If reconnection is requested outside of normal business hours, a \$100.00 after hours reconnection fee will apply. Methods of payment: cash, check, money order, credit card, echeck online or you may now call City Hall to make your payment during regular business hours.
